

How To Install A Plugin

From The WordPress Plugin Directory

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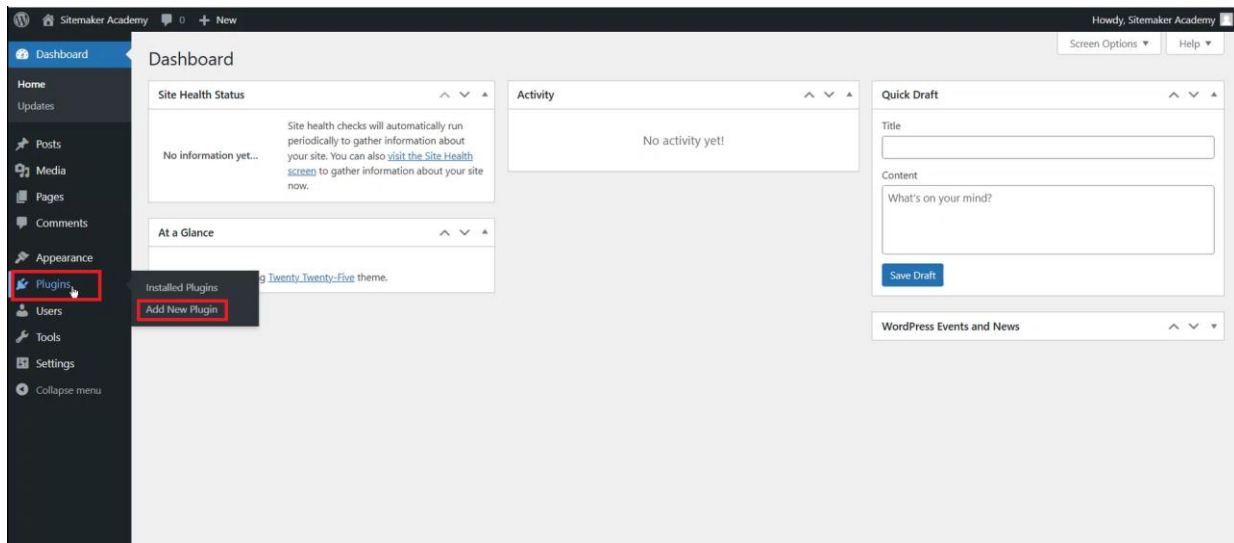
Introduction

WordPress plugins are essential tools that enhance your website's functionality. Plugins make it easy to customize your site without any code. The simplest way to install a plugin is through the WordPress Plugin Directory, which contains thousands of free plugins.

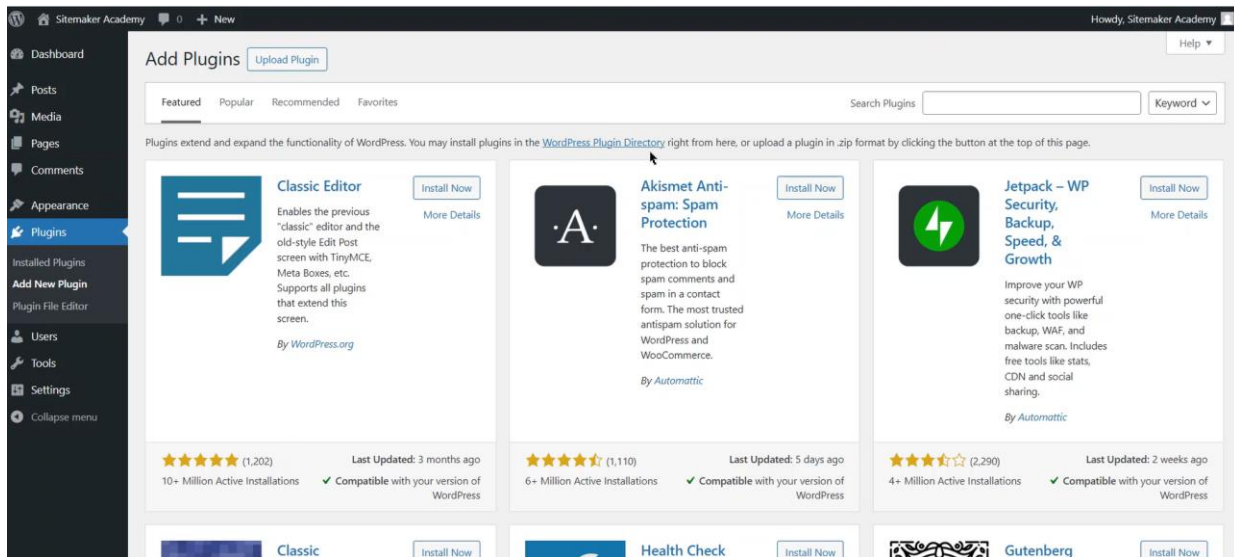
This guide will walk you through how to **install and activate a plugin** using **WordPress plugin directory**.

Step One: Access the Plugin Directory

1. Login to your **WordPress dashboard**.
2. On the left sidebar, click on **Plugins > Add New Plugin**.

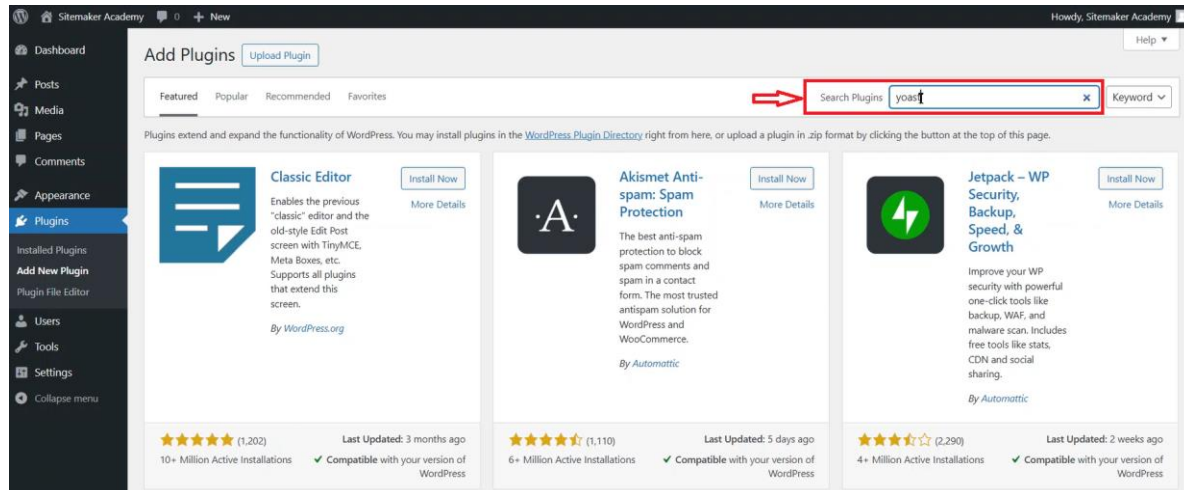


This will bring you to the **WordPress Plugin Directory**.



Step Two: Search the Plugin Directory

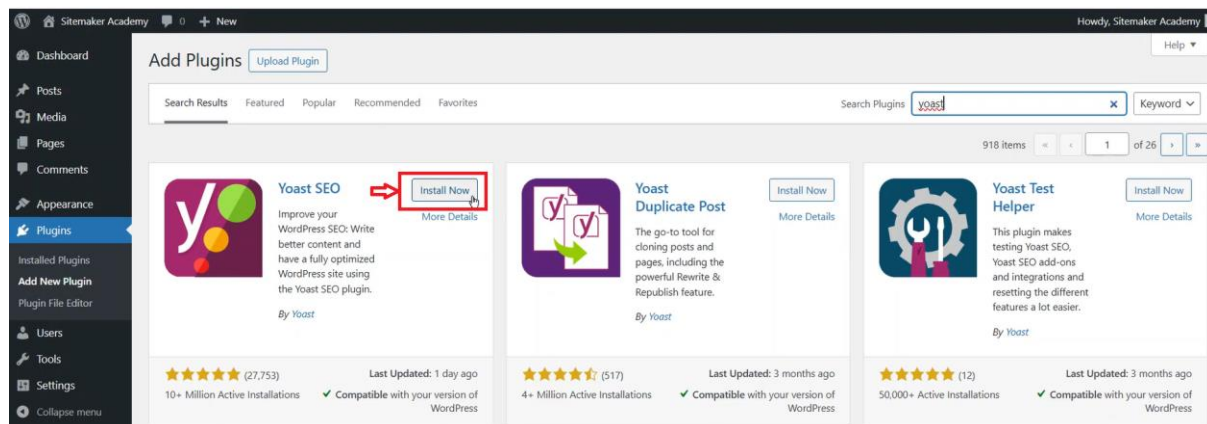
1. Go to the **search bar** at the top right side.
2. Type the full name, partial name, or function of the plugin you are looking for.
3. Press **Enter**.



WordPress will display relevant results along with ratings and descriptions of the plugins.

Step Three: Install the Plugin

1. Once you find the plugin you want, click the **Install Now** button next to it.

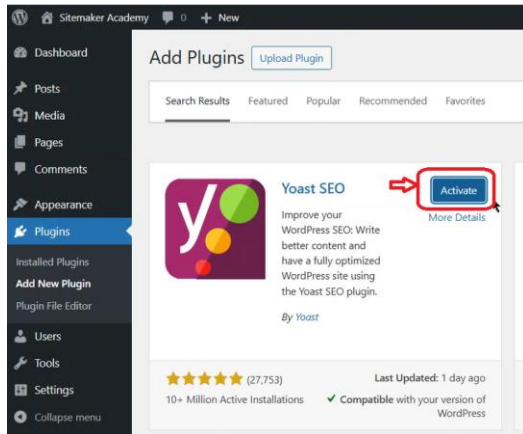


WordPress will automatically download and install the plugin on your site.

Step Four: Activate the Plugin

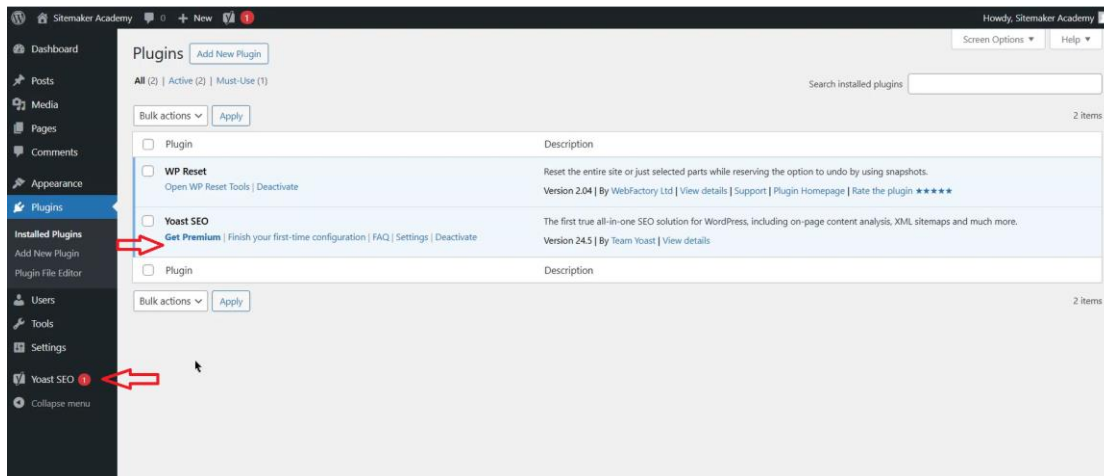
After installation, the Install Now button will change to Activate.

1. Click **Activate** to enable the plugin on your website.



Step Five: Configure the Plugin (if Needed)

Some plugins work immediately after activation while others require configuration. After successful installation, the plugin should appear in the installed plugins list.



1. Go to the left sidebar and click **Plugins > Installed Plugins**. Your plugin should be in the list of available plugins.

2. Click Settings (if available) to configure the plugin according to your needs.

Some plugins also appear on the left sidebar of the WordPress dashboard.
